This new album is not only the heir to a musical journey but also to a philosophical legacy passed on by Jorge Milchberg: the idea that music is not an end in itself, but a path toward a space where we are all connected. Thus, "Más allá de las palabras" expresses what words cannot convey, crossing the boundaries of thought and inviting us to listen to the invisible: the echo of a living tradition, matured over time yet always faithful to its essence.
